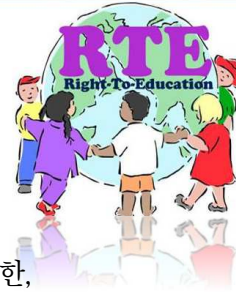

시대와 적응

지난 주보의 글에서 'autonomous'라는 단어에 대한 소고를 나누어 보았습니다. 다시 떠올려 보자면, 이 단어는 '자주적인, 자율적인' 뜻을 지니고 있습니다. 그리고 그 안에는 환경과 주변의 변화에 맞추어 자신을 변화해나감, 그 변화에 맞추어 나가는 의미가 숨겨져 있습니다. 환경에 적응(adapt)함이 없이 자율적이고 자주적인 존재방식은 현실에 있을 수 없습니다.

그런데 환경에 적응한다는 것은, 많은 고민과 통합적 사고가 이루어져야 하는 과정입니다. 그 답을 찾아나가는 과정은 힘이 들고 시간이 필요할 수 밖에 없습니다. 그렇기에 그러한 변화를 피하고 싶어하는 것은 우리에게 당연한 일일 것입니다. 이는 우리의 일상을 흔들고, 혼란스럽게 할 뿐만 아니라, 우리를 피곤하게 하기 때문입니다.

그러나 우리의 신앙에 있어 'accountability'는 중요한 부분이기때, 그러한 변화 안에서의 수고로움을 미워하고, 거부할 수만은 없습니다. 우리는 주님의 가르침을 지키면서도, 세상에 새로운 방식으로 선포하는, '설명해야할 책임'을 가지고 있기 때문입니다. 세상 안의 교회와, 그러면서도 세상과는 다른 교회는, 인간 환경으로부터 영향을 주고 받으면서도, 끊임없이 자신을 쇄신하며 나아왔습니다.

지난 2017년 서울대교구 청년연합회는 청년의 연령을 기존의 35세에서 39세로 조정하였으며, 주교좌성당을 비롯한 성당들은 청·장년층인 45~50세까지도 청년의 범주로 공동체를 이루기도 합니다. 이 또한 교회를 둘러싼 환경적 변화에 따른 적응과 수용이라고 하겠습니다. 이처럼 공동체의 모든 지체는 이러한 변화에 적응하며 나아갑니다. 창조 때에 질서를 부여하신 하느님께서, 그 혼란의 중심에서 우리와 함께 일하십니다.
